

Rules and Regulation of the College

- 1. Students are not permitted to go out during college hours without the prior permission of the head of the respective department.
- Application for leave in prescribed format (Leave form) signed by the student, parent/warden shall be submitted personally the previous day to the tutor concerned/ HoD for prior permission.
- 3. The leave letter submitted after availing leave should be signed by the parents /guardian indicating the reason.
- 4. Second and fourth working Saturdays will be utilized for activities / mandatory / Specialization Courses.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR APPEARING FOR THE SEMESTER END EXAMINATION OF A COURSE.

- I. A candidate who has fulfilled the following conditions shall be deemed to have satisfied the attendance requirements for the completion of a semester.
- 2. Every candidate is expected to attend all classes and secure 100% attendance.
- Candidate who secure, less than 65% of overall attendance will not be permitted to appear for End Semester Examination. The Candidate shall seek readmission to the same semester in the subsequent academic year.
- 4. A Candidate must secure not less than 75% of attendance (after rounding off to the nearest integer) course wise taking into account to the total number of periods required for that course as specified in the curriculum.
- 5. The maximum limit of duty leave exemption to a candidate during a semester shall be limited to 10% of the required attendance in that course. This duty leave is for representation in University / Inter University / State / National / sports events, Co-Curricular activities, paper and / or project presentation with prior permission from the head of institution based on the recommendation of the Head of the Department, provided the progress and conduct of the candidate is satisfactory.
- 6. If a candidate secures attendance between 65% and 75% in any course in the current semester due to medical reasons (hospitalization / accident / specific illness) he / she may be given exemption (due to medical reasons only) to appear for the current semester examinations in that course. Subject to the condition that the candidate should submit, the medical certificate approved by the Head of the Institution based on their commendation of the Head of the Department on the day of resuming to college, after availing leave on medical reason.
- Candidates who secure, less than 65% of attendance will not be permitted to appear for the Semester End Examinations of that course. The candidate has to reregister and repeat that course in the subsequent semester / when offered next.

Fee Payment

The tuition and special fees for every academic year and university examination fees should be paid on or before the last date. The names of those who do not pay the tuition fees on or before the last date will be removed from the rolls. The principal may consider re-admission of such students as per his / her discretion after paying a re-admission fee of Rs. 250/. The tuition fee and special fee, once paid, will not be refunded.

Discipline

- I. Driving a motor vehicle without a valid licence is an offense. The student should wear a helmet while driving the vehicle.
- 2. The use of cell phones inside the classroom is not allowed.
- 3. During class hours, students should practice strict discipline.
- 4. Students must conduct themselves in such a way so as not to bring discredit to the college of themselves.
- 5. Appropriate usage of social media should be strictly adhered to.
- Each Student needs to have an identity card duly signed by the Principal. The card
 will be issued to them immediately after admission to the college. They are always
 expected to have their identity card on a lanyard.
- 7. They must confirm to the standards and modesty maintained by the institution.
- 8. They should not indulge in any untoward activities.
- 9. They should take care of the college property and help keep the premises neat and clean.
- 10. Students should avoid anything, by word or deed, that may disturb the unity and harmony of lif not only in college and hostels but also outside the campus.
- 11. Students are expected to read the notice board every day.
- 12. Students should park their vehicles in the space meant for parking, and they are not allowed to drive their vehicles inside the campus.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited, and any student found guilty of such a crime will be expelled from the college immediately.
- 14. Students are forbidden from organizing any meeting in the college or collecting money without the Principal's permission.
- 15. Severe action will be taken against the students who indulge in or encourage religious activities on the college premises. No student shall take part in any political activity.
- 16. Students are responsible for their belongings. The college will not be responsible for losing personal belongings and valuables.
- Any article in the premises should be handed over to the office with relevant details.
- 18. Internal assessment marks will be awarded to the students based on their performance in internal tests and attendance as per the regulations. Holidays declared by the Tamil Nadu government are declared holidays for the college.

Anti Ragging

The University Grants Commission, vide its letter no. F.I-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated June 17, 2009, has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in institutions of higher learning. The Students are therefore directed to strictly desist from any kind of ragging.

Forms of Ragging: Display of noisy, disorderly behaviour, teasing , expressing excitement by rough or rude treatment or handling; including rowdy, undisciplined activities that cause or are likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm, or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher or asking students to do any act or perform something that such a student will not do in the ordinary course and which causes him / her shame or embarrassment or danger to his / his life.

Punishment for Participation in / or Abetment of Ragging:

- I. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
- 5. Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 7. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters of equivalent period.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-

As per Govt. orders our institute will take very severe action against those indulging in any form of ragging. Hence students are strongly warned to desist from the despicable practice of ragging.

Dress Code

Every student of the college shall wear proper fitting clothes considered decent and acceptable.

Dress Code during Practicals

- Boys: Uniform Pant with shirt tucked in is to be worn along with closed footwear.
- Girls: Overcoat is to be worn over the regular dress along with the shoes.
- Loose garments of any sort and chappals shall not be worn in the practical classes and during field works.

Library Rules

- The library is open from 8.30 am to 6.00 pm on all working days except Government holidays.
- · Silence should be maintained in the library.
- If books are not returned on the due date, a fine Rs. I/- per day up to 15 days will be collected thereafter Rs.2 per day will be levied till the return of the book.
- Students should take care of the books without causing damage of any kind like folding or underlining with a pen or pencil or tearing of pages.
- In case of loss of a book, the student will have to bear the responsibility for replacing
 it with a new one, and if the book is not available, 5 times of the actual cost of the
 book will be collected.
- Students should register their names using ID Cards in the computer kept at the entry counter before entering the library.
- Students ID cards are not transferable
- The librarian may recall any book from any member at any time and the member shall return the same immediately.

Hostel - General Rules & Regulations

- All the Residents should return to the hostel on the reopening date of the college.
- Resident shall neither transfer nor exchange their rooms with other residents.
- The hostel authorities cannot be held responsible for any loss or theft of the belongings of the residents. The residents must make their own arrangements for the safe custody of their property and rooms should always be locked.
- Day-Scholar students are not permitted inside the Hostel. Action will be taken
 against the residents who encourage and permit the day scholar students to stay
 in their rooms.
- Residents are not allowed to do any kind of business inside the hostel.
- Cases of contagious disease shall immediately be reported to Deputy Warden to take preventive measures.
- Study hour will be strictly followed from 08.30 pm to 10.00 pm in the hostel.



- During this study hour, residents are directed not to use music systems/mobile phones/ unnecessary noise/ cause distraction to those who are engaged in their studies/class works.
- After 8.30 pm, residents are not permitted to go to other rooms/blocks.
- In case of emergency, residents are informed to contact Deputy Warden for immediate help.
- Sick students should stay only in the common room during college working hours.
- Hostel gate will be closed between 9.00 am to 5.00 pm during regular working days.
- It is mandatory for the students to be present at 8.30 pm for attendance in their respective rooms.
- Late comers seeking entry in the Hostel after 8.30 pm will be subjected to disciplinary action.

Boys Hostel Rules & Regulations

- Outing is permitted on Sunday from 9:30 am to 6:30 pm after getting the consent from the parents over phone by the respective DeputyWardens.
- Outing on Sunday is restricted to twice in a month.
- Outing on weekdays is restricted to twice in a month with prior and proper permission from their respective Deputy Wardens.

Girls Hostel Rules & Regulations

- Outing is permitted on Saturday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- Outing is restricted to twice in a month.
- The request for outing need to be made with their respective Deputy Wardens on or before Friday. Outing shall be permitted only after obtaining consent from the parents over phone, by the respective Deputy Wardens.
- Students who are in need of going to their native/home should submit a requisition letter to their respective Deputy Wardens on or before Tuesday of the respective week.
- The Deputy Wardens will inform the parents about the departure time of their wards through Phone Call.
- It is the responsibility of the parents to inform the corresponding Deputy Warden
 of the arrival of their ward, via Phone Call.

Autonomous Examinations

The college was awarded academic autonomy from 2017-18 onwards. Thus, the college will conduct all the examinations required for the award of a degree independently. These are a few guidelines for students:

- Semester examinations will be conducted in all the subjects of all semesters in November and April of the corresponding academic year.
- A candidate will be eligible to register for the examination of any semester only if they put in a minimum attendance percentage in that semester as per the regulations.
- The assessment comprises internal evaluation (sessional marks) and performance in the end-semester examination per the regulations.
- Internal marks will be awarded based on continuous evaluations made during the semester of study as per the regulations.
- Laboratory Courses, including project work, also comprise internal evaluation (awarded based on continuous evaluation made during the respective semester of study) and performance in the end-semester examinations.
- The Institute follows grading system for all assessments of courses, including practical courses and project work, as prescribed by Anna University.
- The grading and credit system will be as prescribed by Anna University.

INTERNAL MARKS

UG & PG

External and Internal mark component for all UG / PG courses will be 40:60 for Laboratory Courses, External – 40 Marks and Internal – 60 Marks.

External and Internal mark component for all UG / PG courses will be 60:40 for Theory Courses, External -60 Marks and Internal -40 Marks.






